Have you noticed all the great things that have been going on in our community lately?! There is currently over \$45 million being invested into improving things in Marengo. Here are a few highlights!











#### Iowa Valley School Update

It has been a busy and exciting spring and summer here at Iowa Valleys Schools, and we have some fantastic updates to share with you about our ongoing improvements!

#### **Facilities Upgrades**

Both our elementary and high schools have received new roofs and will soon be fully air-conditioned, ensuring a comfortable learning environment for all our students and staff.

Driving by the high school, you may have noticed the new windows installed at the front and side of the building. This is just the beginning! The high school will also feature new flooring throughout the building.

#### **Classroom Renovations**

Our commitment to providing modern and functional learning spaces continues with significant renovations:

- High School: The industrial tech and FFA rooms are undergoing total remodels. By the end of summer 2025, all high school classrooms will have been remodeled over the past five years.
- Elementary School: We are on track to have all areas remodeled by 2025, with the exception of the new wing that houses our 5th and 6th grade students, which is already up to date.

#### **Looking Ahead**

We are very excited to showcase these improvements and can't wait for our community to see the positive changes taking place. We plan to hold an open house in September, and we hope you will join us to see firsthand the enhancements that have been made.

The Compass Memorial Healthcare expansion/renovation project will provide the hospital with an extra 20,270 new and 22,000 of remodeled square feet after the expansion is complete. A few of the expanded/renovated areas will be Emergency Services (ED), Med Surg (Inpatient), Radiology, Business Office, Finance and HIM among other touches to departments. The emergency services department has currently outgrown their space and will welcome the addition of 4 patient rooms, making a total of 8 rooms for patients needing emergency care. Our med surg floorplan will renovate the already private patient rooms into larger spaces and add two ICU beds for intensive care. The Business Office, HIM and Finance team will be relocated to a new area that is being constructed on the northeast side of the admin structure to allow for their interior space to be utilized for expanded outreach clinics. This will allow much needed growing room for the current Family Medical Clinic that is located inside the hospital's main building.
